Policy of the Board of Directors TITLE 24 ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Purpose

To lower the energy costs of current and future customers by encouraging customers to install sufficient energy efficiency measures to meet Title 24 requirements, while minimizing the use of LP gas, or distillate fuels within the District's service area.

Summary

The District will pay up to a maximum of \$425 for Title 24 calculations for new or existing customers of the District, whose building plans require Title 24 calculations, provided the proposed construction qualifies as "all-electric" as determined by a qualified and licensed architect or engineer.

Eligibility

Participation is voluntary and limited to proposed all-electric residential, multi-family or commercial construction within the District's service territory. The proposed construction must require a line extension or service upgrade to qualify for the Program.

Program

For participating customers the District will:

- 1. Pay for Title 24 calculations for the customer.
- 2. To participate, the customer must submit qualifying Title 24 calculations and execute an Electric Service Contract for a new service location or a service upgrade. If the District pays for the Title 24 Calculations, and the proposed construction is not completed in twelve months after the District completes its connection/line extension work, then the Customer must reimburse the District the cost of the Calculations.

Other

Under this program, the General Manager is authorized and directed to:

- 1. Develop and modify as needed the administrative procedures.
- 2. Negotiate additional discounts on a case-by-case basis.
